Record of Appeal to College Dean**

Instructions for College Dean

1. For detailed instructions regarding Academic Integrity procedures and specific instructions, refer to <http://deanofstudents.arizona.edu/policies-and-codes/code-academic-integrity> under Academic Integrity Procedures III. Appeal to Dean of the College, or contact the Dean of Students Office at 621-7057.
2. Schedule the appeal hearing within 15 days of receipt of appeal for this case. The appeal hearing must be concluded and the decision communicated to the student within 30 days of receipt of the appeal.
3. Determine if the evidence provided supports a conclusion of a violation.
4. If it is determined a violation did not occur, the sanctions imposed must be overturned.
5. If it is determined a violation did occur, determine if sanctions imposed by faculty member is/are appropriate, and either uphold the sanctions, or modify as appropriate.
6. Notify the student of the outcome of the appeal.
7. Send a copy of this form to the faculty member and the Dean of Students Office, Nugent Bldg, Room 100, or email to DOS-Codes@email.arizona.edu.
