Notice of Advisor/Attorney

In accordance with The Arizona Board of Regents Disciplinary Procedures (Policy 5-403), students or student organizations with matters under review by the University Hearing Board may be assisted by an advisor, who may be an attorney. In practice, the Dean of Students office allows students and student organizations, who are either complainants or respondents in Student Code of Conduct disciplinary matters, to be assisted by an advisor, who may be an attorney.

Any student or student organization who is assisted by an advisor during Student Code of Conduct disciplinary proceedings must submit this completed form to the Dean of Students Office at least five (5) business days prior to the scheduled hearing. Students in other stages of the disciplinary process who will be accompanied by an advisor should submit this form prior to meeting with Dean of Students Office staff.
