UA Mall – Designated Public Forum
<ul> <li>□ Government intentionally designates and opens non-public forum to expressive activity by class of speakers</li> <li>□ Neither content nor viewpoint discrimination are allowed</li> <li>□ Time, place, manner restrictions permissible</li> </ul>
Free Speech Test
<ul><li>☐ Is it compatible with the environment/activity?</li><li>☐ If it isn't – offer alternatives</li></ul>
What is Disruptive Behavior?
<ul> <li>□ Behavior that is incompatible with the activity</li> <li>□ Heckling to extent that speaker/audience can't hear</li> <li>□ Provocation</li> <li>□ Harassment (severe, pervasive, repetitive)</li> <li>□ Threatening</li> <li>□ Incitement</li> <li>□ Imminent violence</li> </ul>
What about Hate Speech?
<ul> <li>1st Amendment restricts UA from placing selective limitations on speech/expression if it is insensitive, boorish or expressive view points on disfavored subjects</li> <li>1st Amendment forbids University from regulating or punishing speech or expression of ideas/messages because they are offensive or controversial</li> </ul>
What Can We Address?
<ul> <li>□ Speech which is likely to incite imminent lawless action</li> <li>□ Speech which is harassing (severe, pervasive, persistent, repetitive)</li> <li>□ Speech which is disruptive/not appropriate to the forum</li> <li>□ Discrimination, harassment, retaliation against an individual based on a protected class</li> </ul>
What Should Your Actions Be?
☐ If you think someone (or a group) is being disruptive and/or blocking access to (in or out) of a tent, building or room – but you are not in immediate danger– Call the Dean o Students Office at 520-621-7057
☐ Call 911 immediately to report life threatening situations, immediate danger, or extreme
