

THINGS TO KNOW ABOUT THE **CAMPUS USE POLICY**



The purpose of this policy is to respect the Campus Community's rights to free speech and expressive activity within public and designated public forums, while preserving public health, safety, and welfare; the normal business uses of the campus; and the rights of others to legitimately use and enjoy the campus.



Designated Public Forums such as the Mall may be used by the University Community for free expression, petitions, distributing information



Activities shall not impede traffic ingress or egress or disrupt or interfere with Official /Authorized UA activities



No part of campus is available for organized activities between 10:30 pm and 7:00 am



Signs may never be affixed to plants, statues, lampposts or other inanimate objects on campus nor to interior or exteriors of buildings without prior authorization from the appropriate UA building/structure manager.



Camping is not allowed on University Property



Amplification is only allowed between 12-1 pm and 5-7pm



Structures are not allowed without prior authorization



Dean of Students Office

The Dean of Students has responsibility for administration and implementation of the Campus Use Policy.

Requests for the use of outdoor space, including the Mall and Designated Public Areas on the Mall, must be submitted to and approved **10 business days** in advance of the date the activity is scheduled to take place.
